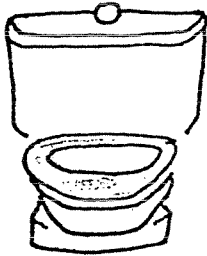


TOILETS AROUND THE WORLD!

Pull straight up!



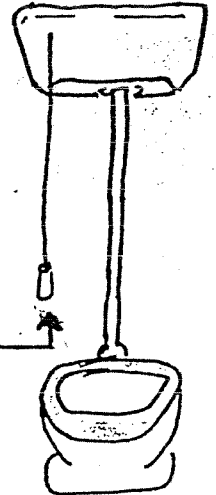
Square push-button type:
Push and hold!



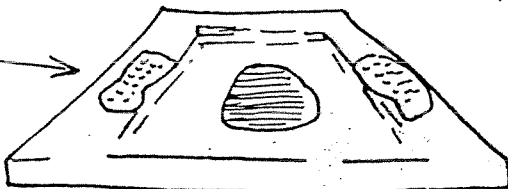
Step on this floor-mounted pedal
to flush.



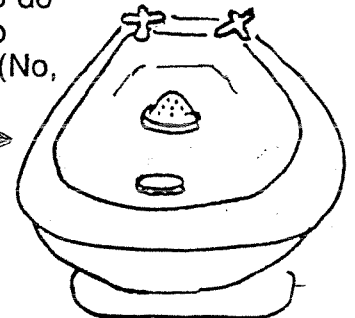
Obviously, you pull the chain
